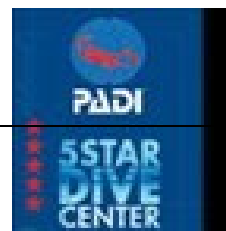

Meaning

Etymologically, **Chi-ch'en Itzá** means “the city on the edge of the Itzáes well.”



Chichén Itzá Archaeological Zone

It is situated 175 km away from Villa Bellamar.

Cultural importance

Chichén Itzá is the best example of the migratory movements that occurred in Mesoamerica towards the **Early Postclassic period**. It brings together material cultural features from both the Maya area and central Mexico, particularly of Toltec affiliation. Besides, Chichén Itzá was the capital of a vast territory in the Yucatan peninsula, headed by the Mayapán league, from 987 until 1200 AD. C. The Chichén Itzá archaeological zone is famous worldwide for **the play of light and shadow** at each equinox on the pyramidal base's steps known as el Castillo. In this one, the sun rises above the horizon and illuminates the western staircase on the plinth, creating triangles of light and shadow that seem to descend to the serpent head in the rest of the construction. This event, achieved from the correct orientation and inclination of the basement plans, manifests the **exceptional level of astronomical and architectural knowledge** that the Mayans possessed, and which has given rise to being one of the most studied cultures and regions around these issues, in addition to territorial political organization and the exploitation of resources.

- Central chronological location: Early Postclassic 900 to 1200 AD. C.

Isla de Cozumel

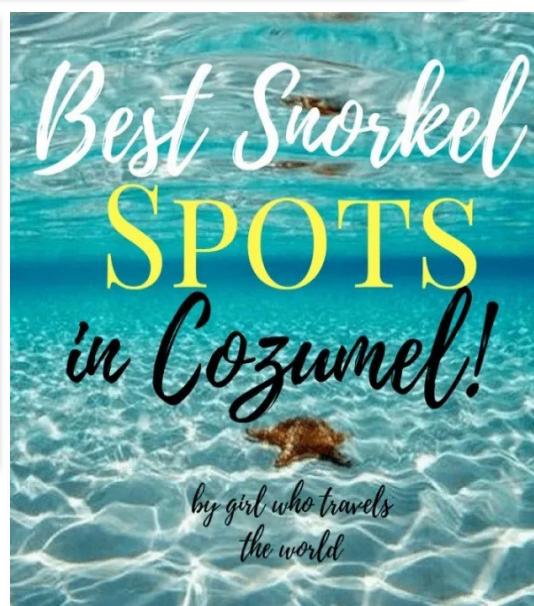
Cozumel is the largest island in the Mexican Caribbean.

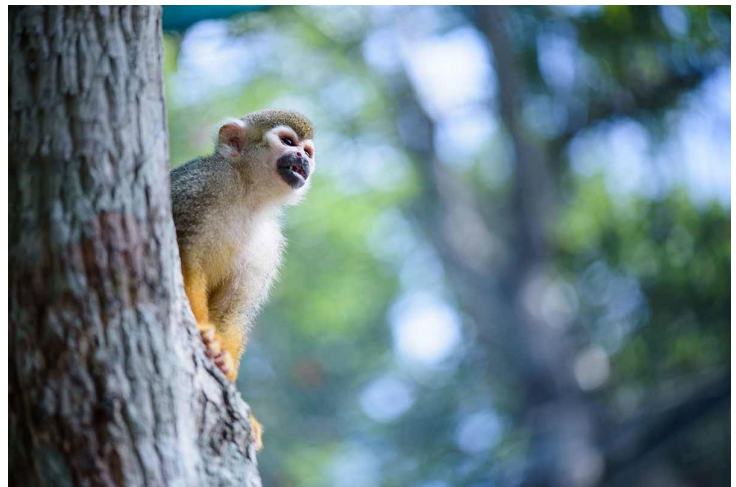

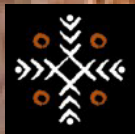

In the heart of Tulum's jungle, Saikuk restaurant & lounge bar is a unique spot, dedicated to the art of living. A festive place where time has no influence and where you can easily get carried by the warmth of its atmosphere.

Tulum Archaeological Zone

Location: 27 km south of Villa Bellamar.

Sources from the 16th century designate the site as "**Zamá**," which in Mayan means "morning" or "dawn." The name of Tulum is relatively recent, and it translates as "wall" or "palisade," referring to the stonewall preserved here.

Cultural importance

Tulum is the most representative site on the Quintana Roo coast, due to its privileged location and the excellent conservation of its buildings and wall paintings. Its wall is well known, delimiting the main complex on its north, south, and west sides, as the eastern sector faces the Caribbean Sea. It has five accesses and two watchtowers.



El Castillo

The highest basement in Tulum, which preserves a temple with three accesses decorated with twisted columns and two zoomorphic masks at the corners, chairs the site. There is a platform for dances in front of the castle. And to the southwest is the Temple of the Initial Series, where the earliest documented date in Tulum was found: A.D. 564.



The Temple of the Descending God is on the north side.

In its small base, a building was erected and decorated with images of that deity. It is the main iconographic element of the city.

In front of this set is the main road with several buildings. The most important is the Temple of the Frescoes. Their mural paintings portray a series of supernatural beings residing in the Underworld, which

constitute one of the most important testimonies of pre-Hispanic Mayan mural painting. Continued on the road, you can see the palaces known as the House of Columns and the House of Halach Uinik.

In the northeast access, the **Casa del Cenote** documents the importance that the Mayans gave to the aquatic cult linked to the cenotes, and near there is the Temple of the Wind God, named for its circular base, related to Kukulcán, the god of the winds.

Services available in the area

- Tulum has an outsourced parking lot.
- The services unit of the site has a store, ticketing area, and toilets. There are facilities for disabled access, from the service unit to the archaeological zone.

PGA Riviera Maya is an impressive piece of landscape architecture where the Robert Trent Jones II team has managed to create a spectacular synergy between the Mayan jungle, natural lakes, cenotes, and its two golf courses, one with 18 holes and the other with 9 par-3 holes.
